Adult Ministries

A Committee of members meets monthly on the second Monday to plan many of the adult activities at St. John's UMC. It is made up of representatives from adult Sunday School classes as well as several "at large" members.

Working closely with this Committee is our Trip Committee which also meets once a month to plan regular outings in Texas and beyond.

"Learning Opportunities"

From January through April and September through December, Adult Ministries sponsors evening Learning Opportunities on the first and third Wednesday of each month. They begin at 6:30, last for an hour and are on topics of general interest.

Periodically, we will also schedule educational series programs, such as Companions in Christ ("The Way of Prayer") and Disciple Bible Studies.

Trip Activities

St. John's Trip Committee has been planning outings to occur almost every other month, most in Texas. However, early in 2008, there was a cruise that went to Mexico, and there is discussion about a possible trip to Alaska in July, 2009. Events scheduled by this Committee are publicized in our Church Bulletins and weekly newsletters.

Game Days & Night

Each month, there are two Game Days which include pot luck lunches. These events begin at 10 a.m. on the second Thursday and again on the second Tuesday following that Thursday. Seniors have a chance to fellowship over dominoes at our Horizon House and usually play in the early afternoon as well.

NOTE: The Seeker's Class also sponsors a Game Night typically on the first Friday evening of each month at 7 p.m.

Events Throughout the Year

Depending upon the time of the year, there are additional activities which adults enjoy sharing with one another. The St. John's Players put on a fall production just before Thanksgiving. Our various choirs offer special programs for the entire congregation. Traditionally, there have been dinners around Valentine's and Christmas.

Bridge Club
